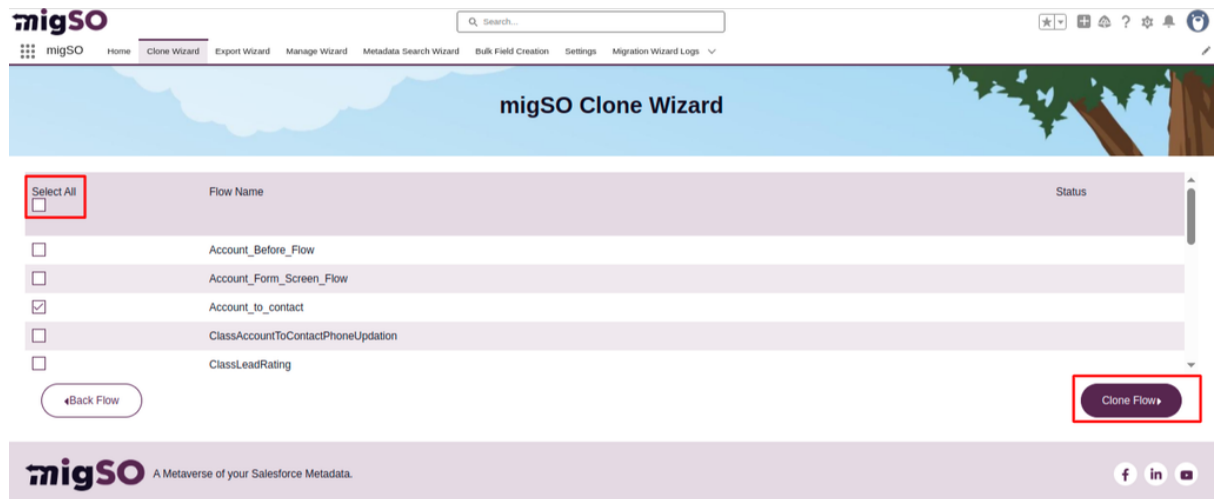
Step 04: Select Source Org

Select the source org or connect a new one. To add a new org, click on the '+' icon, enter details like org name, user name, password, and security token, and click on the Save button.

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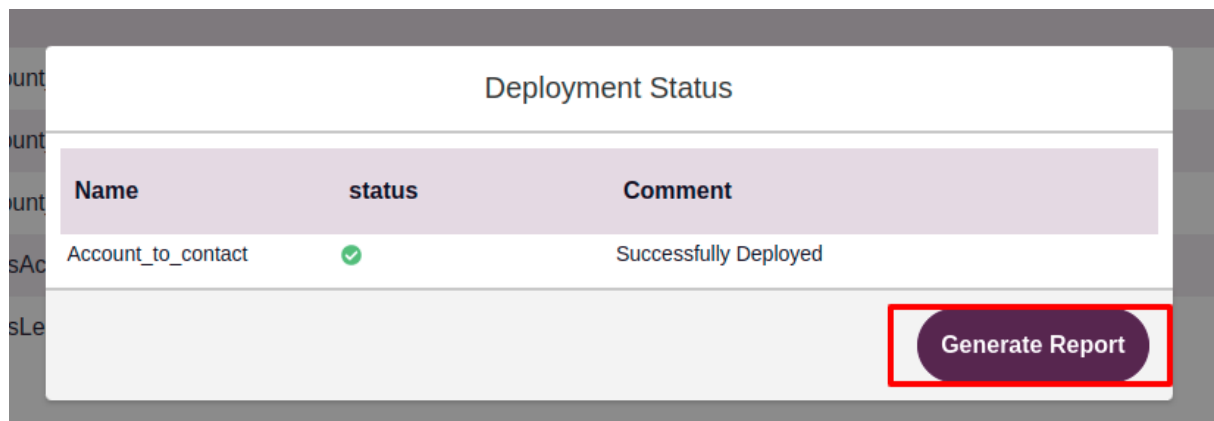
Step 05: Choose Flows & Deploy

Select the flows to clone or click Select All, then click Deploy Flow.



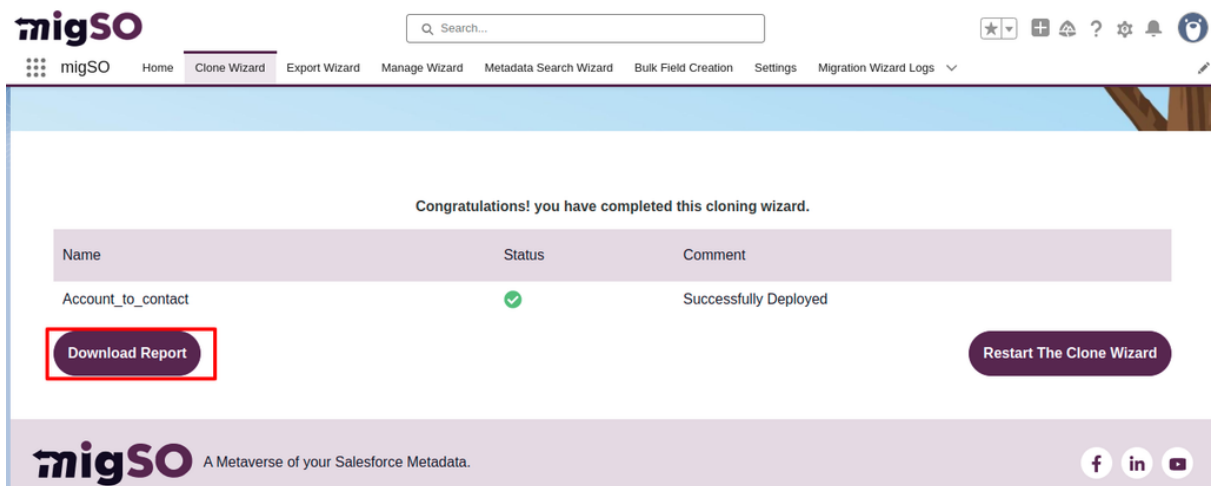
Step 06: Review Deployment Status
